

The drones sector is getting structured, although it is difficult to predict its evolution. At the moment, the biggest problem is the partition in a o f number very small niches, each of them with different needs, and different skills. Moreover, there are many differences between local, regional and national demands for competitiveness, safety and qua-Adaptation lity. changes and need of new skills are a problem for most small companies. The public's acceptance of drones is also a problem, mainly when it concerns the surveillance of public space, because it opens the discussion on respect of privacy. the contrary, the French industry's strong innoviation capacity is an important asset.

REGULATIONS



TECHNOLOGY

Beyond technologies linked directly to the type of services rendered by drones, (payload, data treatment systems) the regulations demands for safety and reliability imply other **DRLes** developments. drones doiventones must be solidly built, to avoid components failures, and also to be able to detect and avoid other trafics. The French competitiveness pends mostly on the capacity to comply to these safety demands, and to the regulations prescriptions, to limit the risks.

COMPETITIVENESS

The development of export sales for the French civil drones sector depends mostly on the capacity to design, build and sell systems complying to the demands of the safety regulations. Many constraints limit the day to day use of drones, these constraints come from the fact that most existing drones were not built with quality standards which garantee security. To wave these limits, conceptors and manufacturers must work on the conception of systems, to avoid components failure, and also on the possibility to respect the air regulations, that is to say to detect and avoid other trafics,. If these conditions are respected, the French industry has all assets to become a leader in the next few years.
